

Clinical Conditions options on GOS(S)1 claim form for eye examinations undertaken on and after 1 August 2025

'The patient Has/Is'	Guidance for completion
None	Select this when none of the other clinical conditions options are selected. Do not leave this section of the form blank.
Has Glaucoma	Select this if the patient has a confirmed diagnosis of glaucoma.
AMD with associated reduced Visual Acuity	This is specifically for age related macular degeneration and not for any macular disease. It is an attempt to gather relevant information on a population basis for this specific and common condition.
Ocular Hypertension	Select this if the patient has a confirmed diagnosis of ocular hypertension (pressure above 21mmHg) but does not have glaucoma.
Diabetes	Select this if the patient has a confirmed diagnosis of diabetes.
Had cataract surgery/pseudo-aphakic	Select this if the patient has ever had cataract surgery.
Cataract with associated reduced visual acuity	Select this if the patient has a cataract that is causing reduced visual acuity.
The visual criteria to be registered as sight impaired regardless of registration status	Select this if the patient meets the definition of 'sight impaired' as set out in Annex B of the GOS Statement .
The visual criteria to be registered as severely sight impaired regardless of registration status	Select this if the patient meets the definition of 'severely sight impaired' as set out in Annex B of the GOS Statement .
Myopia	Select this for all myopic prescriptions with a best sphere prescription greater than or equal to -0.50 DS in at least one eye.
Corrective refractive error	Select this for patients of any age who have a refractive error on any element of the prescription, including reading addition, if the prescription is considered dispensable.
A smoker	Select this for patients who are current smokers (not those who vape).
